## **PLANT ONIONS IN JANUARY! Hurry in for these varieties:**

**1015Y Texas SuperSweet** - Get as big as softballs! This variety produces very appealing globe-shaped jumbos and colossals. A yellow, early-maturing onion recommended for southern and midwest gardeners. It is very disease resistant and will store better than other short day onions.

**Yellow Granex (Vidalia)** - Sweet as an apple! This variety was made famous by the onion-growing area in and around Vidalia, Georgia. It is the earliest-maturing variety available, and is recommended for southern growers. This thick, flat bulb is best when eaten raw. Yellow Granex does not store well. It is sometimes known as the Maui or Noonday.

**White Bermuda** - An old gardening favorite! Great for bunching or eating raw. White Bermuda bulbs are extremely mild. They are thick, flat bulbs that grow best in southern areas. White Bermuda onions do not store well. Also known as the Crystal Wax

**Red Grano (Texas)** - Medium maturity, large red top shaped onion, soft mild flesh, short day, short to medium storage period.

**Candy** - Candy has taken American gardens by storm! No matter where you live, you can grow this huge, savory yellow onion, with thick, succulent flesh and a delicious flavor both sharp and sweet! Candy stores for 3 months. It is a revolutionary new type of onion...neither a long-day (Northern) nor short-day (Southern) variety, Candy is a "mid-day" or day-neutral variety. This means that it can be grown just about anywhere from the far north to the deep south. And it's earlier, larger, and more flavorful than its long- and short-day varieties. **Red Candy Apple** - The ideal red variety for fresh eating or cooking, Red Candy Apple has a delicious flavor so sweet you can eat them raw, but will also add wonderful flavor to any recipe. Plants produce 4 inch, slightly flattened globes of rich, deep red, which store 2 to 3 months. Day neutral type performs well anywhere! 95 days.

**Contessa (White 1015)** - Everyone's favorite, this is the white version of the authentic sweet onion popularized in Vidalia, Georgia. The bulbs are flattened and thick, stuffed with mild, sweet white flesh that can't be beat for raw or cooked enjoyment! This variety has much better storage ability than most sweet short-days, too, so you can keep even more of your delicious harvest! It's the absolute best we have ever grown for overwintering! 110 days.
