Conventional Easy-Timing Calendar

Legend:	F = Feed	T = Transplant	P = Prune	M = Maintenance Task
January F – Cool season lawns with Covington’s Premium 21-7-14 P – Trees and shrubs to shape M – Equipment maintenance – sharpen pruners, lawnmowers, oil, clean, etc. M – Dormant oil to kill scale	February (Yard Clean Up) T – Cool season vegetables M – Apply Dimension pre-emergent to stop weeds P – All non-climbing roses by half M – Weed Free Zone to kill winter broadleaf weeds	March T – Warm season vegetables, warm season color, end of month – <u>avg.</u> last freeze the 17th P – Spring flowering shrubs after they bloom F – Trees & shrubs with Covington’s Special 12-6-6	April T – Veggies, color, sod M – Regular mowing begins F – Lawns with Covington’s Premium 21-7-14 M – Watch for powdery mildew, blackspot, apply ferti-lome Systemic Fungicide as needed	
May T – Hot Summer Color M – Mow regularly and often F – Feed trees, shrubs, flowerbeds with Covington’s Special 12-6-6 F – Lawn every 8-10 weeks with Covington’s Premium 21-7-14	June <u>Water More Often!</u> T – Crape myrtles in bloom M – Mow regularly and often F – Seasonal color and veggies to keep them producing M – Second application of Dimension in early part of month to prevent grassy weeds	July <u>Water More Often!</u> T – Fall tomatoes, crape myrtles M – Mow regularly and often, clean up spring perennials F – Lawn every 8-10 weeks with Covington’s Premium 21-7-14 M – Water new plants often! July and August require it!	August <u>Water More Often!</u> M – Mow regularly and often, trim summer color that needs it T – Crape myrtles, fall vegetables F – Ornamental grasses and shrubs with Covington’s Special 12-6-6	
September (PLANT NOW!) T – Fall Is For Planting – trees, shrubs, grasses, the works M – Dimension pre-emergent to stop weeds F – Lawn every 8-10 weeks with Covington’s Premium 21-7-14 M – Mow regularly and often	October (PLANT NOW!) T – Fall Is For Planting – trees, shrubs, grasses – Fall is <u>the best time all year to do so.</u> T – Ryegrass for winter lawns, pansies and cool season color F – Last call on feeding lawns, feed winter color strongly	November (PLANT NOW!) M – Dunk houseplants coming inside for winter with Orange Oil to kill pests T – Winter color, shrubs, trees M – Water during dry spells, freshly mulch all beds	December T – Trees, shrubs M – Equipment maintenance – tune-ups of power machinery P – Prune out mistletoe if any is seen this month F – Feed winter color strongly
