FEBRUARY'S ORGANIC PLANNING GUIDE

This is a Great Time to Plant!

PLANT:

- **Pansies, kale, phlox, dianthus, alyssum, English daisies, geraniums, snapdragons and more.**
- **Roses** (container or bare-root). Earthkind Roses are heat/drought tolerant & resistant to insects/disease.
- Cool-season vegetables - **potatoes, onions, cabbage, broccoli, asparagus, cauliflower, Brussels sprouts, lettuce, spinach, radish, turnips, snap peas, beets, carrots, collards, chard.**
- **Fruit trees, pecans, grapes and berry plants.**
- **Existing landscape shrubs and trees**, if you need to relocate them.
- **Balled and burlapped trees**, for best results, during dormancy. Still plenty of time to **plant container trees and shrubs**. Plant now to beat the heat!
- **Divide summer and fall perennials** before they germinate this spring.
- **Anything with roots**, use **Covington's Soil Builder**. Contains compost, expanded shale (holds 38% of its weight in water) & greensand to break up clay, add nutrients, retain moisture & revitalize microbial activity.

PRUNE:

- **Fruit trees** to encourage stronger limbs.
- **Groundcovers: asian jasmine, mondgrass, and liriop**e to remove old growth.
- **Trees** to remove dead or damaged growth.
- Those **shrubs** that require heavy shearing and re-shaping.
- **Rose bushes** by about 60%. Be sure and prune out any diseased or dead branches.

FERTILIZE:

- Newly planted trees and shrubs with **Nature's Guide Root Stimulator** every 2-3 weeks to help prevent transplant shock, increase beneficial microorganisms, and encourage root development.
- Use **Nature's Guide Corn Gluten Meal 9-0-0** to feed turf and prevent weeds this spring.
- Plants that aren't thriving with **Nature's Guide Tree Therapy** w/corn meal, molasses, greensand, etc.
- Existing ryegrass and fescue with **Ladybug 8-2-4** or **Nature's Guide 5-3-2**.
- Add **Texas Greensand** for deep greening in lawns, trees and landscape plants.
- Pansies & other annuals, during warm spells, with **Hi-Yield Blood and Bone Meal** to encourage blooms.

BE ON WATCH:

- For bugs use **Ferti.lome Triple Action** which contains Neem Oil, an all-purpose organic remedy.
- Apply **Nature's Guide Garrett Juice** once a month to your landscape to increase beneficial microorganisms in the soil and to reduce the need for water.
- Spot treat grassy and broadleaf weeds with **Nature's Guide 20% Vinegar with 2 oz of Orange Oil added per gallon** during warmer weather.
- Keep **frost cloth** on hand and cover tender plants to protect from freezing weather. Top dress landscape and flower beds with at least a 2 inch layer of **mulch** to help retain moisture and keep soil temperature warmer.

WATER:

- Container plants, flower beds, shrubs & trees as needed to keep healthy and reduce winter damage.
- Trees installed for less than two years must have special care to ensure a strong and healthy root system. See our Plant Article on [Tree Care for the First Two Years](#) on our website or come by and pick one up.
